- II) TCC Updates
 - a) File storage for ALL users to increase to > 1 GBytes by year end. Recently increased from 400-600 MBytes with 350 MBytes added for mail. By year end, will be 800 MBytes + 350 Mbytes of unified storage (no distinction between mail and files). The one GByte figure also applies to departmental and club accounts -- in other words, ALL accounts.
 - b) End Note License changed so that ANY faculty, staff member or student can access it. http://www.nmt.edu/tcc/help/endnote for instructions. Cal asked about Macs, Topliff to look into it.
 - c) WebCT and Blackboard are now one company. A remote server is being tested in two classes.
 - d) Modem charge to increase to \$7. Sonnenfeld asked Topliff to notify all users that they were currently being billed for this. Goal is to reduce costs to departments. Topliff said notification was made one year ago. Sonnenfeld suggested doing again.

2) Network Charges
